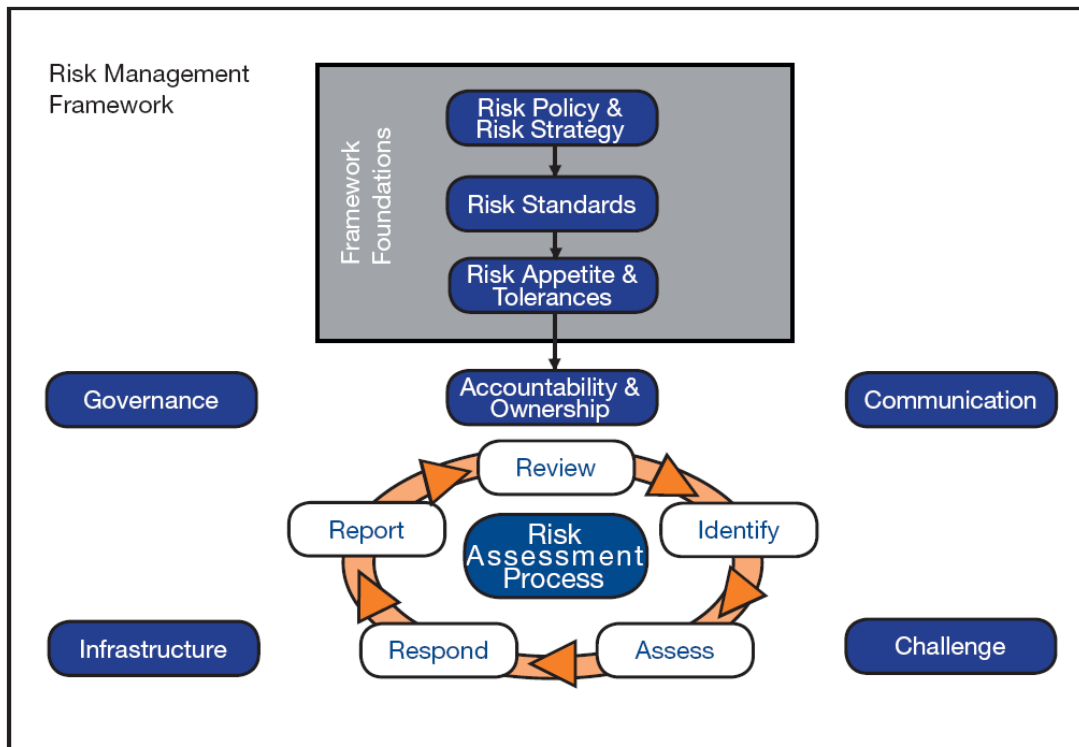


Amlin's Risk Management Framework (RMF) is a key element of the practical implementation of the Target Operating Model (TOM) for the management of Amlin within a Solvency II regulatory environment. It provides the framework within which the governance and accountability for risk are organised. It also sets out the processes required to sustain risk management within Amlin and deliver the overall objectives of Amlin's Risk Management Policy.



A formal Risk Management Framework takes time to implement and is based on the adoption of certain key elements such as a Policy and Strategy to support the development of a risk management culture. Communication, training and awareness are key elements of the framework and leads to establishing consistent and systematic ways of doing things in terms of risk management.
